


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
PROCEDURE


- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Remove the OEM Inner Liners as shown in **Steps 3-4**. If using the Westin Inner Fenders, skip to **Step 5** once Westin Inner Fenders are installed.
- 3. Remove the push pins and fasteners shown in **Figures 1-3.**







4. Remove the plastic rivets along the fender as necessary by pushing in the center of the rivet, releasing the rivet. See **Figure**4. You may then remove the Inner Fender.





- 5. Remove the two bolts securing the OEM Fender to the top supports. See **Figure 5.**
- 6. Remove the bolt toward the front of the fender that secures the fender to the vehicle. See **Figure 6.**






- 7. Unplug the wiring harness for the signal and marker lights. Do so by unplugging only the single plug at the top of the fender well. Slide the red locking tab back, and gently remove the plug. See **Figure 7.**
- 8. Remove the OEM Fender by removing the plastic clips around the fender. See Figure 8.







- 9. Install the Double Sided Tape (3-5) to the fender along the top edge. It will be necessary to trim around the holes. See **Figure 9.**
- 10. Attach the Welting (6) to the installed Double-Sided Tape (3-5). See **Figure 9.** *Note:* The tubed part of the welting should stick just above the top of the fender.





- 11. Place the Tube Fender (1,2) on the vehicle. First loosely attach the fender to the two upper supports using the supplied M6 Hardware and M6 Plate. See **Figure 10.**
- 12. Loosely secure the front mounting location of the fender using the supplied M8 Hardware. See Figure 11.






- 13. All mounting holes that line the perimeter of the fender will receive M6 Hardware. The various bolt lengths and their locations are indicated in **Figure 12** while the general hardware assembly to be used is shown in **Figure 13**.
- 14. Torque all hardware as specified: M6 to 7 ft-lbs, M8 to 18 ft-lbs.







EXPLODED VIEW OF FENDER AND HARDWARE



- 15. In order to connect the new marker and signal lights, remove the old harness from the OEM fender and cut the harness so that only the plug shown in **Figure 15** and wires remain. *Note: Cut the wires as close to the lights as possible.*
- 16. The new lights will be wired into the OEM harness using the supplied Connectors (19). See **Figure 14** for wiring details. *Note: after connecting the correct wires, use a heat gun to shrink the tubing on the connectors (19).*
